### HIGH COURT OF AUSTRALIA

The High Court of Australia is the highest court in the Australian judicial system. Tours of the building bring to life the powerful history and contemporary function of the Court in Australia's democracy. Court Guides engage students in the history and role of the High Court illustrating the relevance and immediacy of the Constitution through recent High Court cases. Students also explore the Australian Constitutional Centre exhibition which brings to life the content of the Australian Constitution with interactive displays.

During sitting weeks, groups observe the oral argument taking place and see barristers present their case before the Justices, subject to seating being available.
